

Regional Glory for Kirsten

Three gymnasts from Harlequin travelled to the Regional Level 4 out of Age Championships on Sunday 9th October 2011, coming away with 4 medals and a regional champion.



Kirsten Evans competed in the 10/11 age group. Starting on floor she performed neatly and effectively to score 11.350. Moving to vault, 2 strong handsprings gained a score of 11.000. Next were bars where she competed a new routine including 2 backward giants to score 11.000. Her final piece was beam where a precise routine with no falls gained her a bonus to finish with a score of 11.650. This meant that her overall score was 45.000 to take the gold medal and regional championship trophy. Kirsten also achieved the second

highest scores on beam and floor to take 2 further silver medals.

Competing in the same age Alissa Denniston also started on the competition on floor and a neat and efficient routine gained her a score of 10.650. Moving to vault she performed 2 accurate handsprings to achieve a score of 10.600. Next was bars where she also performed a new routine including 2 backwards giants and despite a slight mistake achieved a score of 10.100. Finishing on beam Alissa performed a precise, strong and fall free routine to gain a bonus achieving a score of 11.500. This meant that she finished with an overall score of 42.850 in 10th place. Her excellent beam score meant that she took a bronze medal for the third highest score of the day.

In the 12/13 age group Lauren Evans started on beam where a neat and fall free routine gained her a score of 9.350. Moving to floor an accurate new routine achieved a score of 10.600. Her next piece was vault where she performed 2 precise handsprings to score 10.950. Finishing off on bars a solid performance achieved a score of 10.050. This meant that she finished with an overall score of 40.950 in 10th place.
