

Harlequin Gymnasts Tumble to Glory

The middle of November saw the return of tumbling for the Harlequin gymnasts with the Bedfordshire County Championships. Of the 27 gymnasts competing we came away with 23 medals and 11 county champions.

In National 1 Women's tumbling aged 9 / 10 years, Sadie Towell scored 7.60, 4.35 and 8.25 to finish with a total of 20.20 in 8th place. Jessica Denvers scored 8.10, 7.35 and 8.50 to finish with a total of 23.95 in 5th place. Connie Woolhead scored 7.95, 8.05 and 8.10 to finish with a total of 24.10 in joint 3rd place. Clare Stringer scored 8.05, 7.70 and 8.35 to finish with a total of 24.10 in joint 3rd place. Freya Grey scored 8.10, 7.75 and 8.40 to finish with a total of 24.25 to take the silver medal. Jade Leighton scored 8.20, 7.75 and 8.55 to finish with an overall total of 24.50 to take the gold medal and county title.

In National 2 Women's tumbling aged 9 / 10 years, Simone Brodrick scored 7.9, 8.05 and 8.05 to finish with a total of 23.95 to take the bronze medal. Natasha Cordery scored 8.3, 8.1 and 8.45 to finish with a total of 24.85 to take the silver medal. Daisy Brandom scored 8.4, 8.5 and 8.45 to finish with a total of 25.30 to take the gold medal and county title.

In National 2 Women's tumbling aged 11 / 12 years Ellie Woolhead scored 8.4, 8.25 and 8.35 to finish with a total of 25.00 to take the gold medal and county title.

In National 2 Women's tumbling 13+ years Lauren Evans scored 8.15, 8.2 and 8.3 to finish with a total of 24.65 to take the gold medal and county title.

In National 3 Women's tumbling under 13 years Amy Thurgood scored 8.05 and 6.70 to finish with a total of 14.75 in 4th place. Chloe Dymock scored 8.1, 7.8 and 8.2 to finish with a total of 24.10 to take the bronze medal. Nico Brodrick scored 8.1, 7.85 and 8.30 to finish with a total of 24.25 to take the silver medal. Abi Tingey scored 8.2, 8.00 and 8.3 to finish with a total of 24.50 to take the gold medal and county title.

In National 3 Men's tumbling under 13 years Max Rowlands scored 8.1, 7.55 and 5.50 to finish with a total of 21.15 to take the gold medal and county title.

In National 3 Women's tumbling over 13 years, Marguerite Pope scored 7.95, 8.1 and 8.25 to finish with a total of 24.30 to take the silver medal. Jade Redrup scored 8.35, 8.3 and 8.5 to finish with a total of 25.15 to take the gold medal and county title.

In Elite 1 Women's tumbling aged 11 / 12 years, Georgia Batten scored 7.9, 7.8 and 8.15 to finish with a total of 23.85 in 4th place. Freya Nelson scored 8.2, 8.05 and 8.75 to finish with a total of 25.00 to take the bronze medal. Alissa Denniston scored 8.15, 8.4 and 8.75 to finish with a total of 25.30 to take the silver medal. Kirsten Evans scored 8.4, 8.45 and 8.7 to finish with a total of 25.55 to take the gold medal and county title. Kirsten also received a trophy for the highest score of the day by a female tumbler.

In Elite 2 Women's tumbling 10 / 11 / 12 years Mollie Walsh scored 7.9 and 8.2 to finish with a total of 16.10 to take the bronze medal. Sofia Walker scored 8.35, 8.25 and 8.60 to finish with a total of 25.20 to take the silver medal. Jessica O'Sullivan scored 8.2, 8.4 and 8.65 to finish with a total of 25.25 to take the gold medal and county title.

In Elite 2 Women's tumbling aged 13 / 14 years Gemma Carder scored 8.1, 8.2 and 8.5 to finish with a total of 24.80 to take the gold medal and county title.

In Elite 3 Women's tumbling aged 13 / 14 years Emily Cullum scored 8.1, 8.4 and 8.25 to finish with a total of 24.75 to take the gold medal and county title.
