3 REGIONAL MEDALS FOR THE GIRLS IN OUR GENERAL SQUAD


On Sunday 19th June, 5 gymnasts from Harlequin travelled to Pipers Vale gymnastics club in Ipswich to compete in the Regional General Apparatus Finals.

In the Level 3 age 12-14 age group there were 2 gymnasts competing for Harlequin. On vault Tallulah Cotgrove scored 10.60 taking 7th place and Freya Clawley came in 6th place scoring 10.70. On the bars Freya Clawley scored 10.40 coming in 8th place. On the beam Freya Clawley took 5th place scoring 11.60 and Tallulah took a bronze medal scoring 11.80. On the floor Freya Clawley scored 11.1 coming in 11th place.

In the Level 4 age 10-11 years Amy Mason scored 10.60 on vault taking 6th place and Ellie-Mae Eaton took 5th place scoring 10.65. On the bars Amy Mason scored 9.60 coming in 13th place. On the beam Ellie-Mae Eaton took the bronze medal scoring 11.85. On the floor Amy Mason scored 11.50 coming in 11th place and Ellie-Mae Eaton scored 12.8 taking the silver medal.

In the level 4 age 12-14 years Chloe Cuddy scored 10.70 on the bars coming in 6th place. Chloe scored a 11.65 on beam also coming in 6th place. On the floor Chloe scored 12.25 coming in 7th place.

A big well done to all 5 girls. It was a successful day all round especially as there were no falls on beam which is the hardest gymnastic trick to master.

HARLEQUIN NOW HAS 5 FLOOR AND VAULT COUNTY CHAMPIONS

On Sunday 5th June, the girls from Harlequin's Artistic squads travelled to Salto Gym Club in Luton to compete in the county 2-piece competition. With 24 gymnasts attending we were the largest club competing and we took home 16 bronze medals, 15 silver medals, 11 gold medals and 5 trophies!

In the level 7 age 7-8 there were 3 gymnasts competing. Hannah Cladd came in 4th on vault, 6th on floor and 5th place overall. Amy Sayell came in 5th on vault, 4th on floor and 4th overall. Ruby Perkins took a gold medal for her vault with her winning score of 10.80. Ruby also took a bronze for her floor and a bronze medal overall.

In the level 7 age 9-10 Shae-Amari Feckleton came in 4th place on vault, floor and overall. Ruby Reyner came in 8th place on vault, took a silver for her floor and finished in silver medal position overall.

In the level 6 age 7-8 Evie-Mai Crossley took a silver medal for her vault and came in 4th place on floor and overall. Darcey Wraight took all 3 bronzes for her vault, floor and overall score.

In the level 6 age 9-10 Imogen Cook took a bronze medal for her vault and came in 4th place on floor and overall. Emma Layzell came in 4th place on vault, took a bronze for her floor and a bronze medal overall.

Elizabeth Hardie took a silver medal for her vault and a gold medal for her floor with a score of 11.85, taking the silver medal overall. Cassidy Pratt took all 3 gold medals home, scoring 10.45 on vault, 11.85 on floor and 22.65 overall taking the trophy and becoming county champion!

In the level 6 age 11+ Olivia Lawrence came in 7th place on vault, 5th place on floor and 7th place overall. Chloe Leslie took a silver medal for her vault, a bronze medal for her floor and took a silver medal for her overall score.

In the level 5 age 10-11 Freya Inns took a silver for her vault, a gold medal for her floor score of 11.80 and a silver medal overall. Madison Thomson took a gold medal for her vault score of 10.95, she took a silver for her floor and took the trophy and county champion title with her overall score of 22.55.

In the level 5 age 12+ Annabel Cook took a bronze medal for her vault, she took a gold medal for her floor scoring 11.80 and took bronze overall. Madison Ferguson took a gold on vault scoring 11.00, a bronze medal for her floor and came in silver medal position overall.

In level 4 age 10-11 Mia Davis came in 4th on vault but took a gold medal on floor scoring 12.25, coming in 4th place overall. Morgan Cook took a bronze medal for her vault, silver medal for floor and a bronze medal overall. Bethany Smith took a gold medal for her vault score of 11.25 and came in 4th place on floor.

Bethany scored 23.05 overall taking home the trophy and the county champion title. Caitlin Garbutt took a silver medal on vault and a bronze medal on floor. She too scored 23.05 overall meaning she also took home a trophy and the county champion title.

In the level 4 age 12+ Madison Wraight took a gold medal for her vault score of 11.20, a silver medal for her floor and she took home the county champion trophy with an overall score of 23.25.

In the Level 3 age 12+ Jade Leighton came in 4th place on vault, floor and overall. Clare Stringer took a silver medal on vault and a bronze medal on floor, taking the silver medal overall.

A big well done to all the girls who competed, everyone did extremely well.
