Harlequin School of Gymnastics competed in a National Final in less than a year of starting a new discipline. The club started Teamgym in August 2011. This is where they perform a floor routine with up to 12 competitors at once. Then 6 of the team perform tumbles, then a trampet section and a trampet vault, all performed to music. The club qualified from a Regional competition in Scotland in March. They then went onto compete in the National Final in May in Glouster . They scored 37.95 which was a whole mark more than in March. This put them in 8<sup>th</sup> place against 14 qualifing teams. They are 8<sup>th</sup> in the country at Primary Teamgym.
