National Glory for Harlequin Tumblers

May saw the Harlequin tumblers make their annual journey to the National finals at Fenton Manor in Stoke on Trent on the hunt for National titles.

Saturday was the turn of the national level tumblers. In National 2 Women's age 13+ years Ellie Woolhead scored 25.50 on her first tumble and 25.80 on her second to go through to the final in 2nd place. A strong final tumble scoring 27.30 meant that she finished with a total of 78.60 to take the bronze medal in her first national final.

In National 3 Women's under 13 years Abi Tingey scored 24.15 on her first tumble and 23.70 on her second to go through to the final in 6th place. In a very tight group she scored 25.65 on her final tumble to finish with a total of 73.50 in 6th place.

In National 3 Men's under 13 years Max Rowlands scored 24.15 on his first tumble and 23.85 on his second to go through to the final in 6th place. A solid final tumble scoring 24.15 meant that he finished with a score of 72.15 in 4th place.

In National 3 Women's age 13+ years Marguerite Pope scored 25.50 on her first tumble and 25.35 on her second to go through to the final in 1st place. A slight hiccup on her final tumble meant that she scored 25.05 to finish with a total of 75.90 and in the cruellest of count backs finished in 5th place despite having the same score as second.

Sunday was the turn of the elite level tumblers and in Elite 1 Women's age 11/12 years Kirsten Evans scored 24.30 for her first run and 23.70 for her second run to place her in joint 5th place going into the final run. An excellent tumble scoring 27.90 meant that she finished with a score of 75.90 in 4th place.

In Elite 2 Women's age 10-12 years Nico Brodrick scored 22.05 for her first tumble and 22.50 for her second. This unfortunately wasn't enough to qualify for the final run and she finished in 15th place with a score of 44.55 in one of the largest and most competitive groups of the day.

In Elite 2 Women's age 13/14 years Jessica O'Sullivan scored 25.20 on her first tumble and 25.20 on her second to take her through to the final run in 1st place. An excellent final tumble that scored 27.75 meant that she finished with a total of 78.15 taking the gold medal and national title by 1.35 marks.

In Elite 2 Women's age 15+ years Gemma Carder scored 24.30 on her first tumble and 24.00 on her second to go through to the final in 5th place. A strong final tumble which scored 27.60 meant that she finished with a total of 75.90 in 4th place.

In Elite 3 Women's age 13/14 years Emily Cullum scored 24.45 on her first tumble and 25.20 on her second to go through to the final in 2nd place. A strong double twist tumble which scored 27.00 meant that she finished with a total of 76.65 to take the gold medal and national title.
