Again Harlequin has seen success in the various competitions our squads have competed in over the summer. The County 4 piece took place here at Harlequin on Sunday the 14th of September. Gymnasts from all over the county came to compete on all 4 of the artistic pieces of which include bouncing over the vaulting table, swinging on the asymmetric bars, balancing on the beam and tumbling on the floor. We had gymnasts competing in nearly all categories from artistic level 7 to artistic level 3 with ages ranging from 7 to 16. Our squads came back very successful with 19 bronzes, 32 silvers, 27 golds and 6 county champions!
