ASHLEIGH AND ELLIOTT AT BRITISH TUMBLING CHAMPIONSHIPS

Ashleigh Kemp and Elliott Browne proudly competed at this year's British Tumbling Championships in Liverpool Echo Arena on Saturday 2nd and Sunday 3rd of July. After qualifying in June both gymnasts tumbled well to place in the Final.

This was Ashleigh's first time competing in a British final and she tumbled exceptionally. After performing a beautiful double tuck somersault dismount, she came in 10th place. This is an amazing achievement for Ashleigh's first year competing at this high level. She has an exciting future ahead and we can't wait for next year's season!

Our Elliott Browne did not fail to impress. He has worked extremely hard to perform a fantastic new skill; he had audiences stunned at his difficulty and variation. Elliott finally got a chance to be the first British gymnast to compete a full twisting triple pike back somersault dismount, of which he landed with his usual flare. This is a massive achievement for him. Elliott is leading the way for British tumbling, encouraging others in his team to push for skills that are higher in difficulty value. Elliott placed 2nd and took the Silver medal; a big well done to Elliott. Harlequin is so proud of you and what you're achieving.





SUCCESS FOR ALL 3 OF OUR TUMBLERS AT THE NATIONAL NDP FINALS

Congratulations to all 3 gymnasts who competed for Harlequin at the National NDP Finals on 9th & 10th July in Telford.
