Madison, Thalia, Morgan, and Bethany all competed on Bars and placed the team in 4th place.

On Beam, Madison, Thalia, Morgan, and Bethany competed and placed the team in 6th.

Madison, Morgan, Caitlin and Bethany all competed on floor and placed the team in 4th place.

On Vault, Madison, Thalia, Caitlin and Bethany competed and placed the team 5th. With Madison scoring 11.200 which was the second highest vault score of the competition. Well done Madison!



COUNTY ACRO COMPETITION – 20TH NOVEMBER 2016

On Sunday 20th November, Harlequin saw 16 gymnasts travel to Salto to compete in the Bedfordshire County Acro Championships.

In the Grade 2 Women's Pairs saw Maddie Lacey and Isla Eldridge score 24.11 to take the silver medal in their first ever competition! Well done girls!

In the Grade 2 Women's Groups Freya Clawley, Evie Leeks, and Hayley Vuksanovic scored 24.3, coming 4th overall.

In Grade 3 Women's Pairs Maddy Ferguson and Neve Heydon scored 23.6, coming in 9th place. Jessica Sunderland and Abi Leslie also competed in this group and scored 24.19 to come in 6th place overall.

In Grade 3 Mixed Pairs Aiden Coe and Abi Leslie scored 24.7 to take the gold medal! Congratulations to the pair!

In the Grade 3 Women's Groups, Chloe Cuddy, Isabelle Walford and Maisy Parsons scored 24.21 to come 5th overall.

In Grade 4 Women's Groups, Carla Danby, Chloe Leslie and Izzy Jackson scored 24.22, coming 4th and narrowly missing out a medal!

COUNTY TUMBLING COMPETITION – 20TH NOVEMBER 2016

On Sunday 20th November, saw 23 gymnasts travel to Salto Gymnastics Club in Luton to compete in the Bedfordshire County Tumbling Championships.

In National 1 aged 9&10, we had Evie-mai Crossley scoring 77.900, earning her the silver medal, Ruby Rayner scoring 76.600, earning the Bronze medal, Darcey Wraight scoring 72.100 to come 5th, Amy Sayell scoring 72.800 coming 4th and Shai-Amari Freckleton scoring 78.500 to take Gold and become County Champion.

In National 2 aged 9&10, some fierce competition, Imogen Cook scored 73.3 coming 6th. Charlotte Bolton scored 75.600 to come 5th, Elizabeth Hardie scored 78.000, to take the silver medal, Cassidy Pratt score 77.800, taking the bronze medal. Clara Foster, scored 75.800, coming 4th and Emma Layzell scored 78.800, to take gold and become County Champion.

In National 2 aged 11&12, Caoimhe Todd scored 74.400 to take the Silver medal. Olivia Lawrence scored 77.100, taking the gold medal and becoming the County Champion.

In National 3 aged 9&10, Thalia Marrone scored 78.300 taking the gold medal and becoming the County Champion.

In National 3 aged 11&12, Freya Inns, scored 77.300 taking the gold medal and becoming the County Champion.

In National 4 aged 9&10, Bethany Smith scored 76.100 to earn the silver medal and Caitlin Garbutt scored 78.700 to take the gold medal and become the County Champion.

In Men's National 4 aged 11&12, Enrique Parazan-Butler scored 78.700 to beat his competition and take the gold medal become the County Champion.

In National 5 aged 10&12, Madison Wraight score 76.800, taking the bronze medal, Morgan Cook scored 78.400 to take the silver medal and Mia Davies scored 78.700 to take the gold medal and become the County Champion.

In National 5 aged 13&14, Clare Stringer scored 79.400, to take the gold medal and become the County Champion.

Clare also earned an extra trophy for being the highest scoring Tumbler of the day!

In FIG aged 13/14 saw Ashleigh Kemp take the gold medal after competing both her high level tumble scoring 52.000

Well done to all gymnasts who competed. They took home an amazing 16 medals between them!
