

Harlequin's Amazing Results at the English Tumbling Championship

Harlequin Gym Squad took 11 gymnasts to Telford to take part in their first English Championships. Each gymnast had to complete 3 runs, 2 consisted of National tumblers and the 3rd was a British tumble, this was new to all the gymnasts as their final run had more difficulty. They all did exceptionally well, and the scores show how hard they have all worked for it. Harlequin brought home 7 medals including 4 Champions from across the weekend.

In Silver NDP 2 F Age 9-10yrs

Darcey Wraight was against 11 other gymnasts, to score 80.10 to come 2nd and take the Silver Medal.

In Silver NDP 2 M Age 11-12yrs

Joshua Skidmore was against 13 other gymnasts, he scored 78.20 to come joint 4th place. This was his first national competition.

In Silver NDP 4 F Age 11-12yrs

We had Cassidy Pratt, who scored 64.80 to come 15th Overall, and Elizabeth Hardie who scored 79.60 to come 1st, taking Gold Medal and the title of English Silver Champion NDP 4 Age 11-12yrs 2018. Both girls tumbled tremendously as they were against 16 others.

In Silver NDP 5 F Age 10-12yrs

There were 11 gymnasts in this category. Imogen Cook tumbled herself to a score of 77.5 to come 5th Overall. We also had Caitlin Garbutt with 3 clean runs to score 83.10, to come 1st taking the Gold medal and claiming the title NDP 5 Age 10-12 English Champion 2018.

In Silver NDP 5 M Age 10-12yrs

We had Aston Fairbanks who tumbled extremely well to score 81.10 to come 1st, taking the Gold medal and claiming the title Silver NDP 5 Age 10-12 English Champion.

In Silver NDP 6 F Age U13's

Just 2 gymnasts in the category, Morgan cook, who scored 74.00 to take the Silver Medal and Bethany Smith who scored 78.40 to come 1st taking the Gold medal and the Title Silver NDP 6 Age U13's English Champion.

In Silver NDP 7 M Age 13+ yrs

We had Enrique Parazan-Butler, with 3 amazing runs including his double somersault. He scored 77.90 to take home the Silver Medal.

In Silver NDP 7 F Age 13+ Yrs

Clare Stringer should have competed, unfortunately due to an injury she did not compete. We look forward to her quick recovery and see her in Birmingham at National Semi-Finals.
