General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

New legislation called the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is now in place and set to become adopted by UK law. All companies and businesses within the UK and the EU will have until May 2018 to ensure they are compliant with the new regulation. Superseding the Data Protection Act (1998), it affects how organisations obtain, use and retain their data in their day to day work.

With this in mind, our governing body; **British Gymnastics** has changed the way you are able to register your child for their membership which includes their insurance for gymnastics training. Within the first 2 weeks of joining, you must register your child via the British Gymnastics website in order to continue training at Harlequin. Without it, unfortunately, we are unable to accept your child as they will not have valid membership or insurance. Harlequin will only hold data on our system which we need to enable us to process your child(ren) classes, payment and pass on information.

The Paysubsonline.com team have been working with a certified data practitioner to ensure our system and internal processes supports us with the compliance of the new GDPR.

It has come to our attention that some children are being dropped off early for their gymnastics class. Can I remind you that our **Duty of Care** is from the time they are recorded on the register. Please do not leave your child in the building unsupervised, if we need to evacuate for any reason we are only aware of the gymnasts who have signed in, therefore you are still responsible for them.

I must also point out that when your child's session finishes you must come in and collect them, we will not allow them to leave unattended or with another child under the age of 18 years. If you child is old enough to walk home we will only allow this to happen if we have written consent from their parent / guardian.
