On Sunday 10th March 8 gymnasts competed in the Eastern Region Acro Preliminaries. For some pairs this was their first Regional level competition! With so much experience gained, and score improvements made these pairs did Harlequin proud.

There were 3 Harlequin pairs competing in the Grade 1 Women's Pairs. Lucy Bender & Amelie Cunningham came in 11th place overall scoring a total of 21.700.

PIPER'S VALE PRE-GRADES CHAMPONSHIPS - NDP & COMPULSORY LEVELS

23rd & 24TH MARCH 2019

Starting off the Artistic Grades season 7 gymnasts travelled to Ipswich to compete in the Piper's Vale Pre-Grades championships. With such a big entry the competition was spread over 2 days with nearly 400 competitors entered. This event gave our gymnasts the chance to perform their grades and gain high level competition experience ready for the up and coming season.

On Day 1, Saturday 23rd March, we have 4 gymnasts entered. In the first round of the day we had Teegyn Jefcoate and Gracie-Mae Jones were first to compete in the NDP Club Grade 5 Age 9. Teegyn came in 10th place overall with a score of 59.800. Teegyn did take a bronze medal for her floor score of 12.700. Gracie-Mae came in 7th place overall with an overall score of 60.850.

In the second session it was Leyla Chambers and Harriet Lugg's turn. Both competing in the NDP Club Grade 6 Age 8. With 50 gymnasts in this group the competition was tough. Leyla Chambers came in 24th place scoring 60.300 overall. Harriet Lugg took a bronze medal for her Range & Conditioning score of 13.150. She came in 19th overall scoring 61.400.

Day 2, Sunday 24th March, there were 3 gymnasts to compete in the National and Compulsory grade levels. in the first session Bella Williams and Lucy Walsh were competing in the National Grade 5 Age 9-11. Bella came in 10th place with an overall score of 59.000. Lucy Walsh performed her way to success taking a silver medal on vault & floor. She also took the gold medal for beam and took the overall trophy with a final score of 62.800. Well done Lucy! In the last session of the day Kardelen Kaya competed in the Compulsory 5 Age 8. EASTERN REGION TUMBLING PRELIMS - NDP & FIG LEVELS

17TH MARCH 2019

On Sunday 17th March Harlequin took 22 gymnasts to Kingston Gymnastics club for the Regional Tumbling Prelims. Most gymnasts where going with new runs and nerves where running high.

In the first session of the day we had the National 1 and 2 gymnasts taking part, each category was large and had tough competition.

In NDP 1 - Women's tumbling 9/10 years, Teegyn J was our only competitor from Harlequin against 16 others. An overall score of 51.70 to be placed 13th. In NDP 1 - Women's tumbling 11/12 years, Isabelle W, again was our only competitor for Harlequin against 26 others. An overall score of 74.90 to be placed 10th. In NDP 1 - Men's tumbling 11/12 years, we had Alfie S, and Jude W. Alfie was competing for the first time and with some errors in his runs he scored 26.90 to be placed 3rd and taking the Bronze Medal. Jude scored 72.00 overall to take 2nd and bring home the Silver medal and qualify for National Semi in Birmingham. In NDP 2 – Women's 11/12 years, Emma L and Ruby B competed for Harlequin. Emma scored 53.00 overall to be placed 4th. Ruby unfortunately did not complete her runs and did not place. In NDP 2 – Men's 11/12 years, Charlie B was our only competitor for Harlequin with a score of 77.80 to be placed 2nd and take home the Silver medal and qualify for National Semi's in Birmingham.

In the afternoon session, we had the National 3 – FIG Performance gymnasts. In NDP 3 - Women's 11/12 years we had 3 gymnasts compete who did amazingly well. Ulani H scored 75.70 to be placed 3rd taking the Bronze medal. Shai F scored 77.50 to be placed 2nd and take the Silver medal and Darcey W scored 75.7 to come 1st and take the Gold medal. Shai and Darcey both qualify for the National Semi in Birmingham. In NDP 4 – Women's tumbling age 13+ we had 3 gymnasts take on a large group. Elizabeth H scored 74.80 to be placed 6th overall. Freya I scored 75.50 to be placed 5th overall and Cassidy P tumbled well to score 77.40 to come 2nd and take the Silver medal and also qualify for National Semi's in Birmingham. In NDP 4 – Men's tumbling age 13+ Josh S was our again only competitor for Harlequin in this category. He scored 75.60 to come 1st taking the Gold medal and also qualifying for Semi's. Moving on to the new category of FIG development, who also needed to qualify for the National Semi-finals in Birmingham. In FIG Development age 11/12, we had Imagen C to score 160.3 to come 1st taking the Gold medal. In FIG Development age 13/14, we had Morgan C to score 171.50 to come 1st taking the Gold medal. tricky tumbles to score 167.40 to be placed 1st and bring home the Gold medal. All gymnasts



In total we will be taking 11 gymnasts to Birmingham in June for the National Semi-finals, to then hopefully tumble into the Finals in Coventry.
