

## General Gymnastics Level 1 and 2 Regional Apparatus finals, Ipswich

On Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 4 gymnasts from Harlequin competed in the General Gymnastics Level 1 and 2 Regional Apparatus finals in Ipswich. This was the first time any of these gymnasts had competed at a regional event.

On Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> June, another 2 gymnasts made the journey to compete in the General Gymnastics Level 3 Regional Apparatus finals.

In a very close competition for Level 3 Girls, aged 11-12, Marcia Winter received a bronze medal for her vault. Imogen Ward came 10<sup>th</sup> on bars, 10<sup>th</sup> on beam and 5<sup>th</sup> on floor.
