Spring Cup 1 – 10 April 2022

On Sunday 10th April Harlequin took 6 gymnasts to Telford International Centre to start the competition season off. They took part in the Tumble Spring Cup 1.

On Saturday we started with the Age 9/10 Yrs. The boys it was their 2nd competition ever and they had worked extremely hard for it.

They had to complete 2 tumble runs to qualify for the final later in the afternoon. Both Jaden and Riley qualified for the final.

They competed a 3rd run for it to be added to the scores from earlier in the day the results where:

Jaden Finch – 5th Overall – score of 55.20

Riley Fendick – 3rd Overall – score of 56.70 – claiming the Bronze Medal

Then came the Age 11/12 yrs

This category was a tough round and out of 14 **Cooper Moore came 9th in qualifications**, missing finals by 0.01. Well done Cooper.

Later on Saturday we had the 13/14 yrs.

We had one competitor in this category, he has worked extremely hard to be here after such a bad year of injuries.

Aston Fairbanks came 10th Overall – score of 40.70. Unfortunately, not going through to finals.

On Sunday it was the turn of the older groups. We had 2 competitors in the 17/21 girls group.

Clare Stringer – tumbled very well and qualified for the final in 1st place with a score of 42.90.

Georgi Issott – completed her 2 runs and qualified for the final in 5th Place with a score of 41.50

In the final they complete 1 run with the scores being zero. They have 1 chance to do their best. The final results for the 17/21 age group is:

Georgi Issott – 1st Place – score of 23.60 – claiming the Gold medal with a new run.

Clare Stringer – 3rd Place – score of 21.80 – claiming the Bronze medal, also with a new run.
